Invitation to Webelos Scouts

Boy Scout Troop Four of Milford will be holding our fall camp out & pig roast at our troop campsite in Milford on Nov 17 and 18. We are inviting Second Year Webelos and their parents to attend. There will be outdoor games and scoutcraft activities. The event features the Troop Four famous "Roasted Beast" which has included a hearty meal featuring a Pig Roast, Roasted Turkey's or a old fashion woodland BBQ over the recent years along with traditional fixings, open to all scouts, webelos scouts and parents. Traditional roasted Hot Dogs are always available too.

All Second Year Webelos Scouts and their parents are invited to enjoy our dinner and take part in our campfire later in the evening. Webelos and their parents will be able to stay in tents (provided by the troop) and we will provide an outdoor breakfast the next morning. If you can not stay for the overnight, Webelos and their parents have the option of leaving after the activities on Saturday evening.

Webelos who participate in the event will complete the outdoor Boy Scout Troop activity requirement for their Arrow of Light Award.

When & Where: The camp out will be Saturday, Nov 17 to Sunday Nov 18. Webelos and their parents should meet at our troop campsite at 11:30 AM Saturday morning. Our troop campsite is located in a wooded area next to St. Mary's cemetery off Cedar Street in Milford. To reach our campsite, drive in the main gate of the cemetery on Cedar Street, take a left, go past the Irish round tower, and continue to the cemetery maintenance shed. Parking is next to the maintenance shed. Parking is very limited, so if you can buddy-up with other Webelos and their parents for transportation, it would be a big help. Scouts from the troop will lead you on the 100 yard walk to the campsite.

After lunch, Boy Scouts will assist Webelos and their parents in setting up their tents. After an afternoon of activities, we'll have the Roasted Beast dinner and campfire. Breakfast and morning activities will be completed by 9:30 AM Sunday morning.

What to Bring: Webelos should wear old, comfortable clothes, with comfortable sneakers or hiking boots. Be sure to bring a jacket along with mittens/gloves and a hat. This is a rain or shine event, so bring a poncho or raincoat. Bring a bag lunch with a drink for Saturday lunch. Each person will need a sleeping bag in a waterproof bag (a plastic trash bag is fine). Other things to bring:

- Canteen or water bottle (full)
- Flashlight
- Extra socks and underwear
- Clean up kit (soap, towel, toothbrush/toothpaste, toilet paper, and washcloth)
- A duffel bag, pack or day pack/school pack to hold everything (except the sleeping bag)

Things you may want to bring:

- Foam pad or air mattress to sleep on
- Jackknife (if you have a whittling chip)

Invitation to Webelos Scouts

The troop will provide a complete dinner and breakfast along with all the eating utensils, cups, plates, etc. We will also provide all Webelos and their parents with tents to camp in overnight.

What We Need: We need to know by Sunday, Nov 4 how many Webelos and their parents will be attending, and if you will need a tent from the troop to use. - 8:00 PM Campfire
- 10:00 PM Lights Out
- 7:30 AM (Sunday) Breakfast
- 9:30 AM Morning activities concluded.
